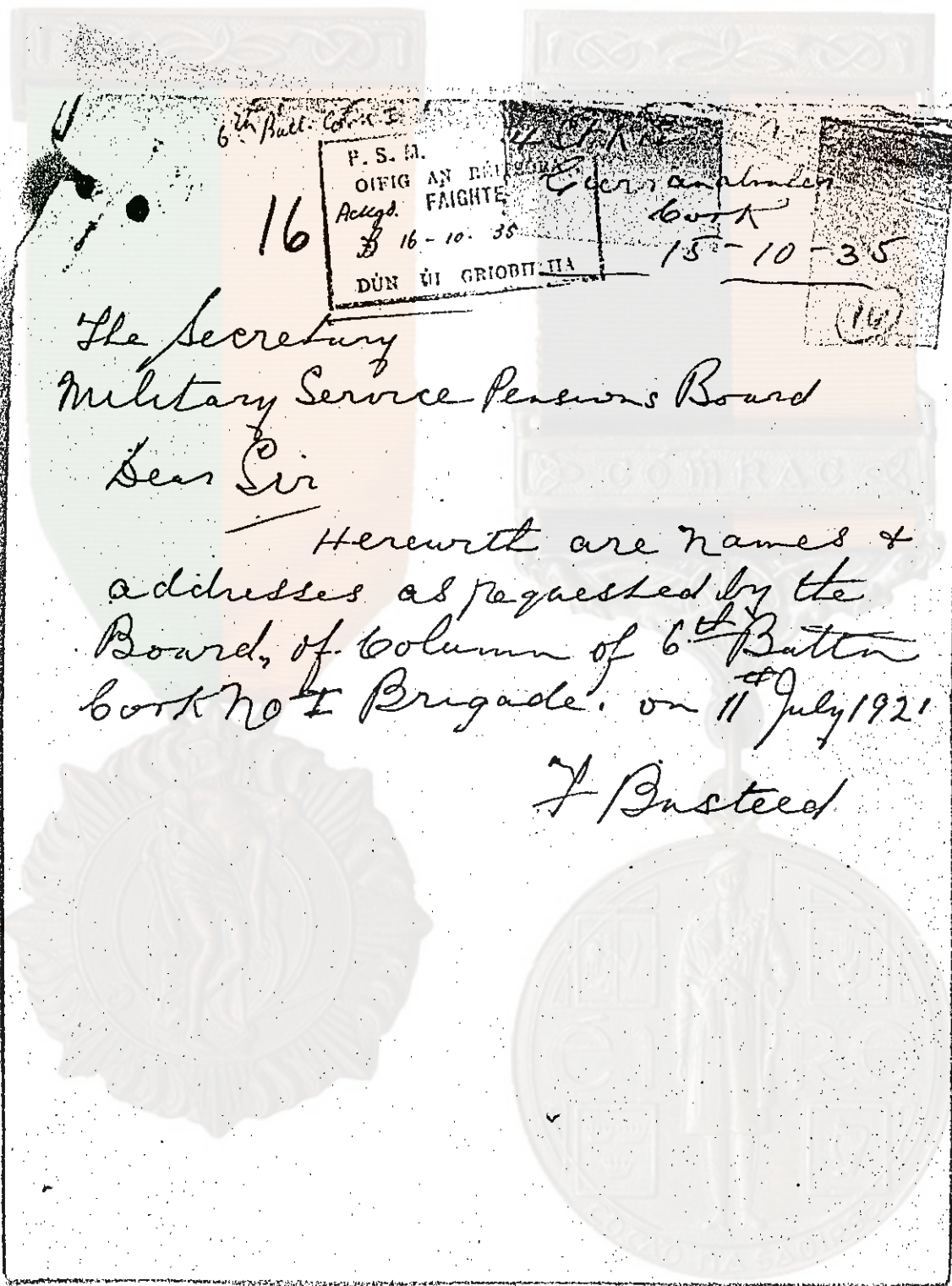

This is to certify that Edward Fitzgibbon served with the rank of Captain in the Victoria Barracks, Cork, prior to and after the attack on the Four Courts.

I wish to appeal the award made to me under the Military Service Pensions Act, 1934, Ref. No. 34.SP/2097, on the grounds that I have further evidence to submit on my claim for Rank, which evidence I did not submit in the first instance owing to the rush at that particular time, the time of the first callings for examination from Cork City.

Enclosed please find the following :-

- (1) Letter from Mr. Sean Hegarty, Brigade O/C.
- (2) Letter from Mr. Daniel O'Donovan.
- (3) The following statement which has been submitted to the City Council for their verification.

On the 24th June 1921, being a member of the Cork City A.S.U. at the time I received the following command from the O/C. of the City :-

"The Captain of your Company (D/Coy. 2nd Battn) is in bad physical condition, go to Douglas, take over duties as Company Captain, and proceed with the attack on Douglas R.I.C. Barracks".

I did as ordered and took over duty from the Captain and directed and engaged in the attack on the Barrack, placing the original Company Captain in charge of a section. Subsequently and until the Truce, I continued as Company Captain of D.Coy. 2nd Battalion, Cork No. 1 Brigade.

During the Truce the work of the A.S.U. was of such a nature as to make it impossible for me to carry out the duties of Company Captain and the First Lieut. was then appointed to that position.

When Union Quay Barracks and in turn Cork Barracks were taken over I was immediately appointed Company Captain on the arrival of Volunteers for training purposes, and I held that Rank all the time in Cork Barracks until the outbreak of the Civil War when I left the Barracks as O/C of a Column of 150 men.

I would further bring to your notice the fact that early in 1923 I was appointed as Headquarters Staff Officer by Tom Barry.

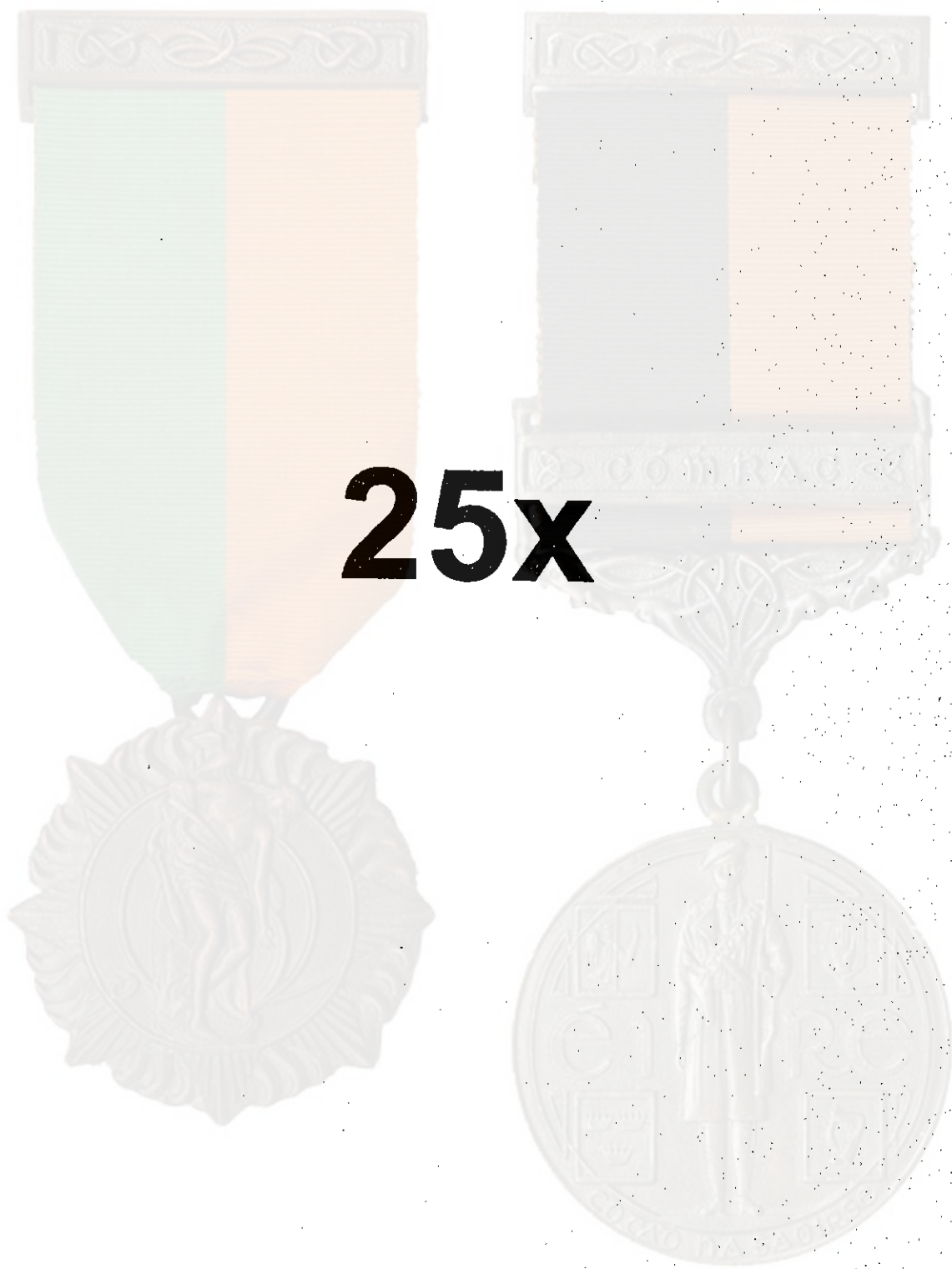

A Chara,

I am directed by the Referee to refer to representations which have been received recently regarding the application of Sean Murray, 78 Westbourne Park Villas, Bayswater, London W.2, and to state that certain enquiries were addressed to your Committee through Mr. T. Crofts on the 20th October last regarding this application and those of Messrs. Peter O'Donovan (29066) and Herbert J. Mitchell (2459). In the correspondence in question (1) it was pointed out that, in addition to these three applicants each of whom are certified by your Committee to have held the rank of Column Commander on 1st July '22, three other applicants i.e. Edward C. Fitzgibbon (1884), John J. O'Leary (2110) and Daniel Donovan (1181) have already been awarded rank as Column Commanders on that date, and (2) your Committee was requested to state whether these six cases exhaust the number of bona-fide claimants to the rank of Column Commander on 1st July, 1922. To date no reply has been received to the latter query and I am, therefore, to enquire whether your Committee are now in a position to reply thereto. If, in the opinion of your Committee, there are other cases in which a bona-fide claim to the rank of Column Commander can be advanced, I am to request that the names and full addresses of the applicants concerned be stated.

As regards the certificates supplied in each of the cases of Messrs. Murray, O'Donovan and Mitchell, he "had over the requisite number of men under his command" I am to state that certificates in this form do not satisfy the requirements of the Referee and that in each case, therefore, it will be necessary to state categorically whether the strength of his column was over or under thirty in strength on 1st July 1922.

I am to add that further consideration of these applications has been deferred pending your Committee's reply.
