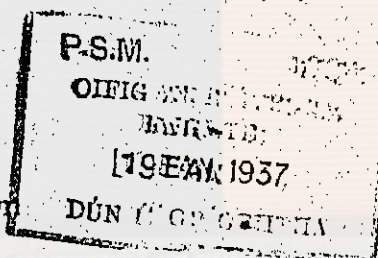

Was 2nd Lieut of Shanballymore Coy at the time of Currys departure to the A.S.U. and automatically took charge of the Coy for a short time until it was reorganised when W.J.Griffin was appointed in November 1920.

W.J.Griffin Skanakilla

Was appointed O.C. Shanballymore Coy in November 1920 and Held that position on the 11th July 1921.

In regard to your communication as to the application of the above named we desire to state that the officer personnel of the Castletownroche Battalion Staff, Cork 2 Brigade, is as follows:

11th July 1921

All these officers were members of the Active Service Unit which they joined in or about the month of October 1920. They were carrying on duties as officers of the Battalion.

We wish to point out that the Brigade was reorganised shortly before the Truce and as a result of that re-organisation the 6th Battn. (Castletownroche) was shortly after the truce formed into two Battalions, the 4th and 2nd. Richard Smyth was appointed Vice Commandant of the 4th Battalion which position he held until the second critical date.

In regard to the column of which Richard Smyth was in charge in July 1922, we beg to state that this column was in or about 34 men formed in Fermoy Barracks and consisted of men of Cork I and Cork 2 Brigades. Columns at the beginning of the Civil War were constantly changed in personnel.
