A Chara,

I am directed by the Referee to enclose herewith particulars of organisation records for the 3rd Brigade, 4th Northern Divn. In addition, separate copies of the roll of every sluagh in the Brigade for each of those dates are required. I am, accordingly, to request your Committee to be good enough to wake arrangements for the compilation and transmission of these records at the earliest possible date.

I am to add that consideration of the applications which have been received from former members of the Brigade has been deferred pending receipt of the required particulars.






