MacNicholas, Paddy Colgan being appointed Battalion Q.M.

P. Dunleavy, 1st Lieut., Bohola Company, though not formally appointed O.C. Bohola Company on second critical date was acting as such. Martin Casey, Goulane, Kilkelly, acted as O/C. Kilkelly Co. since formation of same till his arrest on 3rd July 1921.

T.P. Johnston, who was O/C. Kilkelly Coy. on 11th July 1921, was, during Truce, appointed Asst. Brigade Q.M. The late T. Campbell replaced Johnston as O/C. Kilkelly and acted as such till Martin Casey's release from internment. Tom Murray, who was O/C. First Aid in Battalion, on 11th July 1921, was, during Truce, appointed Brigade M.O.

M. MacHugh, who was Battn. I.O. on both critical dates last contact with Battn. after second critical date and in the end of July 1922, Joe Colgan was appointed to do the work. James Lavin, Kiltimagh, acted as Battn. Transport Officer during Truce. He was appointed Brigade Transport Officer in June 1922.
