Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 5th inst. I wish to inform you that Kielduff Company was not attached as a separate Company to the Kerry No. 2 Brigade area on the 1st critical date. It was part and parcel of the Ballymacelligott Company on the 1st critical date. Ballymacelligott Coy was transferred to the Kerry No. 1 Brigade during the Truce and I understand the Ballymacelligott Company was then divided into two Company areas viz:- Kielduff and Ballymacelligott.

Mr. Kennedy, Mr. McEllistrim T.D. and myself discussed the situation and Mr. McEllistrim made a mistake in ~~saying~~ stating that it was in May 1921 Kielduff Company was transferred to Kerry I., it should have been October 1921. Kielduff Company was apparently lettered "K" when it became attached to Kerry No 1. Brigade. In the Kerry 2 Brigade there was only one Company lettered "K" on the 1st Critical date. That Company was Lauragh. Company which was attached to the 3rd (Kenmare) Batt and during the truce Lauragh Company was transferred to the Cork 5 Brigade.

You had a communication from me dated the 27th ulto dealing with this matter.

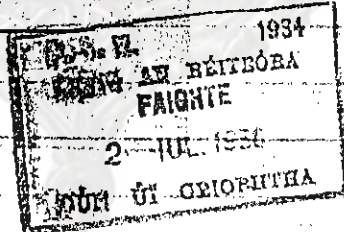

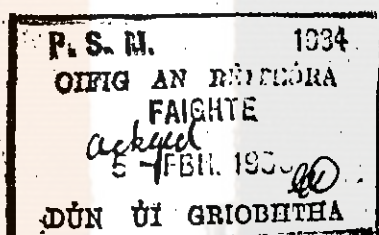
