From records furnished by the Cumann na mBan Committee it would appear that Miss Lizanne O'Brien was President of Tralee District Council on 11th July, 1921 and 1st July, 1922, and applicant was Secretary. As each branch of the District Council was less than 100 in strength, grade D rank can only be awarded in respect of the officer commanding the District Council whose total strength is shown as over 100 on both dates.

Accordingly, I am also to request your Committee to state the name of the person who was officer commanding Tralee District Council on both dates.
