Formerly Miss Marie Perolz, she was intelligence officer in the Irish Citizen Army and worked in close association with James Connolly, by whom she was entrusted with confidential work on the eve of the Rising. She also acted as courier for the I.C.A. and following the Rising was imprisoned in Kimainham Prison and was one of the three women transimprisoned in Kilmainham Prison and was one of the three women transported to Lewes Prison. A few weeks before the Rising she went to Kerry and delivered a lecture, disguised as the Countess Markie-cz who had been forbidden by the R.I.C. to enter Kerry. For over 20 years she acted as Inspector under the Children Act of the Dublin Board of Assistance. Chief mourners were — Mr. M. MacNamara (brother-in-law); Mrs. W. P. O'Donoghue and Miss L. MacNamara (nieces).
