Your letter of the 16th instant re Mrs. D.M. Carolan, 7 Glenarm Ave., Dublin, 9. The position is as follows:-

The late Michael Carolan was granted posthumously a pension of £93.2.6d per annum under the Military Service Pensions Act, 1934 payable from 1st October, 1934. The accrued arrears to the date of death were paid to Mrs. Carolan. There are no provisions in the Military Service Pensions Acts whereby an allowance could be granted to the widow of a deceased pensioner.

Mrs. Carolan applied under the Army Pensions Act, 1932 for an allowance in respect of the death of her husband but the Army Pensions Board reported in 1941 that they were not satisfied on the evidence that the death of the deceased was due to service in July, 1922. The Board reconsidered the case on appeal in 1942 but were unable to alter their findings. The Minister has power under the Army Pensions Acts to request the Army Pensions Board at any time to review their report on the ground that evidence not available prior to the issue of their report has since become available and if Mrs. Carolan can provide such evidence the question of reviewing the Board's report could be considered. In view of the lapse of time since the Board's reports it is very doubtful whether she would be in a position to do so.

The relevant sections of the Army Pensions Act 1968 - which is the subject of your enquiry - apply only to the widows of deceased pensioners i.e. where the deceased was at the time of his death in receipt of a disablement pension. As the late Mr. Carolan was not in receipt of such a pension when he died the provisions of the Act could not apply to his widow.

I regret that I have not more favourable news for you.

A pension payable at the rate of £26.50 a year on 31.12.1952 would be payable at the rate of £104.40 a year as from 1.10.1971. Therefore the minimum widow's allowance of £52.20 a year is appropriate in any case where the rate of pension on 31.12.1952 was £26.50 a year or less.
