

I am directed by the Referee to refer to the application under the above Act of Mr. Edward Gamble, 29, Grattan St., Cork, and to state that the only particulars submitted in connection with Cork No. I Brigade Fianna Eireann show that in the absence of Mr. McMahon, applicant was appointed Acting Brigade Commandant of Cork No. I Brigade Fianna Eireann in 1920. It also appears that Gamble continued to hold the rank of Commandant of the First Battalion Cork No. I Brigade, Fianna Eireann, during the time he discharged the duties of Brigade Commandant and that on the return of McMahon in July, 1921, Gamble continued to act as Commandant of the 1st Battalion, Cork No. I Brigade, Fianna Eireann until August, 1922.

I am to inquire if your Committee can certify that Gamble actually discharged the duties of Commandant of Cork No. I Brigade, Fianna Eireann, in McMahon's absence and if so, the date on which Gamble was appointed Acting Commandant of

the Brigade and also the date on which he ceased to act in that capacity.

I am also to point out that with the exception of Youghal Branch, Fianna Eireann, no records appear to exist or have so far been furnished of the strength of Cork I Brigade, Fianna Eireann, as it existed on the 11th July, 1921, and the 1st July, 1922. Accordingly, I am to enquire if your Committee is in a position to supply particulars of the strength of the Brigade and its component units on the dates mentioned.

I am to add that if any question of rank for a Fianna applicant from Cork No. I Brigade Area (with the exception of Youghal Branch) should arise, records of the strength of the various units comprising the Brigade must be supplied before any claim for rank can be considered.

As it is desired to complete the investigation of this claim at an early date, a reply to this communication should reach this Office not later than the 10th proximo.

The total strength of the Fianna in Cork city on the 11<sup>th</sup> July 1921 was 1100 and in view of this fact alone we cannot understand the reason why your board has not recognised the Fianna in Cork as one of the military organisations that were responsible for that measure of freedom this country gained as a result of the combined activities of these organisations.

Up to date only two officers of the Fianna in Cork have been given an award and the remaining applicants (approx 10) are in receipt of Statutory 21 Day police.

The activities of Fianna in Cork were subject to the Brigade Council S.P.4. and they were strictly confined to a series of activities which they (the brigade) laid down for them, as it was considered that it was in their sphere they would most usefully serve the cause. These outlined activities were Intelligence such as Observation of spies & suspected spies, Observation of enemy Posts & Patrols, Scouting & carrying arms for I.R.A. Ambush Parties, Storing arms, Raids for Boycott goods, Raids on enemy food supplies Raid for arms etc etc. (See Reference enclosed) as a result of their activities several

Francaids were arrested and imprisoned.

It is very unfair that your board have placed (as apparently they have done) the Franco applications on as high a level as those of the I.O.A. The injustice of this is brought home when the age of the applicants is considered, few if any of them having reached their twenty-first on the 11th July 1921.

We would therefore urge your board when considering the appeals of these applicants to give the foregoing points your consideration.
