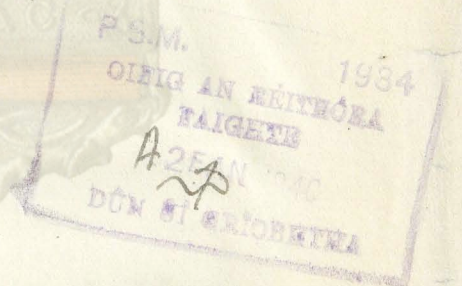



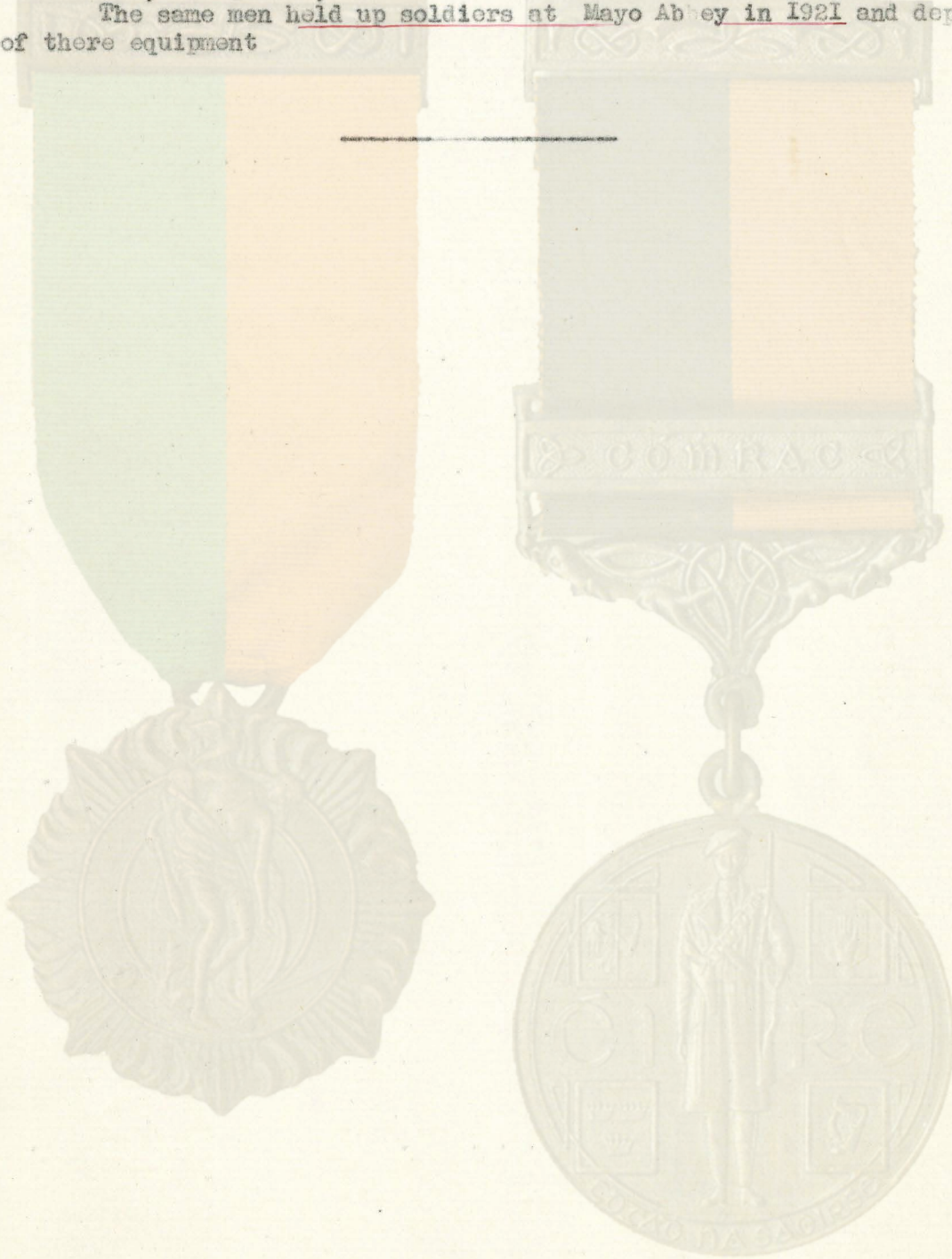

No. 6 Operation.

A party of British military was going towards Claremorris in August, 1920, when their lorry broke down in a place called Holywell. ✓ A guard of from fifteen to twenty armed military camped there until the lorry was removed some days later. The first night the guard was encamped there all available volunteers and arms were taken to Holywell with the intention of attacking the military. However, by the time the volunteers were getting into position to attack, daylight was appearing and they had to withdraw. On the next day a general Battalion mobilisation was ordered, and that night, after posting scouts on all roads leading to Holywell, the Volunteers surrounded and attacked the military guard, with rifles, revolvers and shotguns. After a long exchange of shots, during which from seven to ten of the military were wounded, daylight began to appear and the volunteers withdrew.

As the R.I.C. and Black-and-tans from Ballyhaunis raided only in large numbers, supported by the British military, it was decided to attack them in the streets of Ballyhaunis at nighttime. A party of I.R.A. went to Ballyhaunis for this purpose in March 1921. Stealing quietly into the town they found the R.I.C. and Black-and-tans on the streets and opened fire on them. One Black-and-tan was badly wounded and the others retreated to the barracks.
