Position of the records of 3rd Bde. 2nd N. Div. after discussion with Sergt. Diamond.

According to Sergt. Diamond who was Bde. O/C the 3rd Bde. consisted of four (4) Battalions i.e. Cookstown Batt., Bellaghy Batt., Gortin Batt. and Maghera Batt. on 11/7/21 and of three Batts. i.e. Coalisland Batt., Cookstown Batt. and Bellaghy Batt. on 1/7/22. He says that the Gortin and Maghera Battalions were not transferred to the 4th Bde. 2nd N. Division until after the Truce and further that the 4th Bde. did not exist at all on 11/7/21. Col. McKenna's Committee had furnished records on the basis of the 4th Bde. having ~~been~~ on 11/7/21 with Gortin and Maghera Batts. attached to it on that date. His Committee states, however, that there was no Brigade staff appointed for the 4th Bde. on 11/7/21.

The following are the observations of Sergt. Diamond on the records submitted by Col. McKenna's Committee for the 3rd Brigade. I took down these notes in consultation with him on the 9th and 10th instant and he took away particulars of the discrepancies in order that he can confirm his views at leisure. He promised to communicate again with this office in regard to the discrepancies.

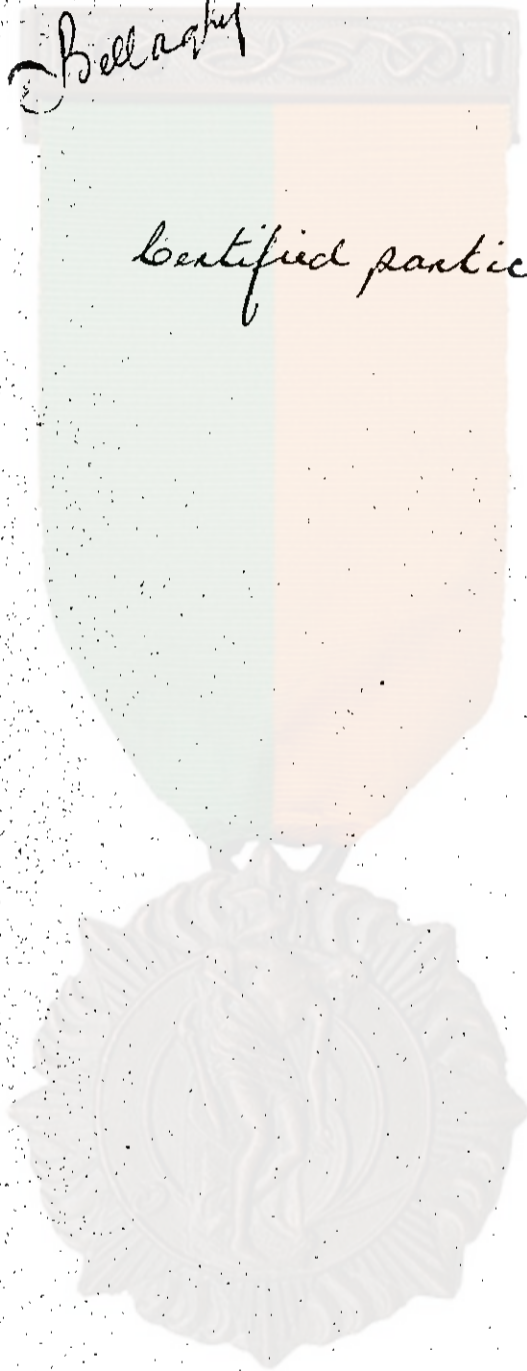
