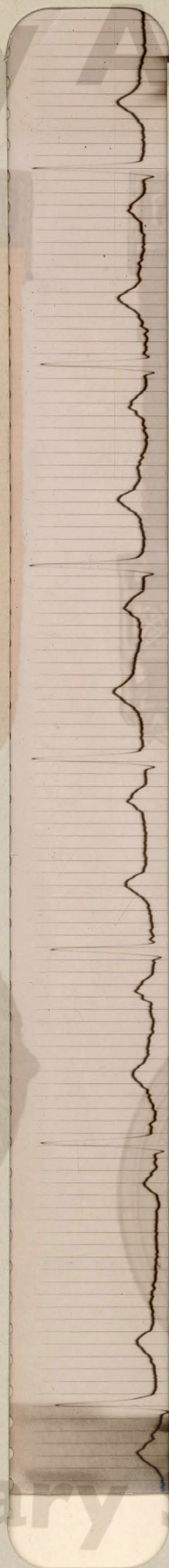
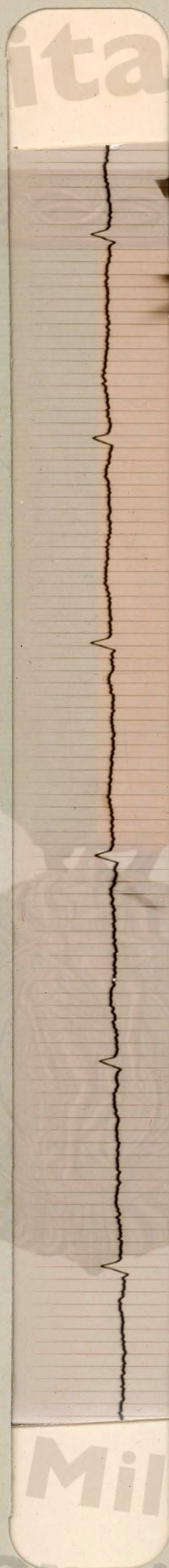

STATEMENT OF MICHAEL CAHILL.

I claim that I am unfit for work due to ulceration of both legs. I have not done any work since January, 1943.

I was working in Roche's Malthouse, Enniscorthy, in January, 1943, and I had been there off and on for years before that.

I have been drawing National Health Insurance since I gave up work. I have 8 in family, one girl is earning 10/- a week and the others are away from home except the youngest, a boy, who has just left school.

The income of household, consisting of myself, my wife and two children is 4/- a week National Health, 10/- a week daughter's earnings and £10.17.10 a year service pension.

I have been attending Dr. Bowen off and on for the past 5 or 6 years for my legs. I was working in England 12 months ago, and I was sent home by the doctor because I was unfit for work. I was employed as a labourer on aerodrome construction in Northants.

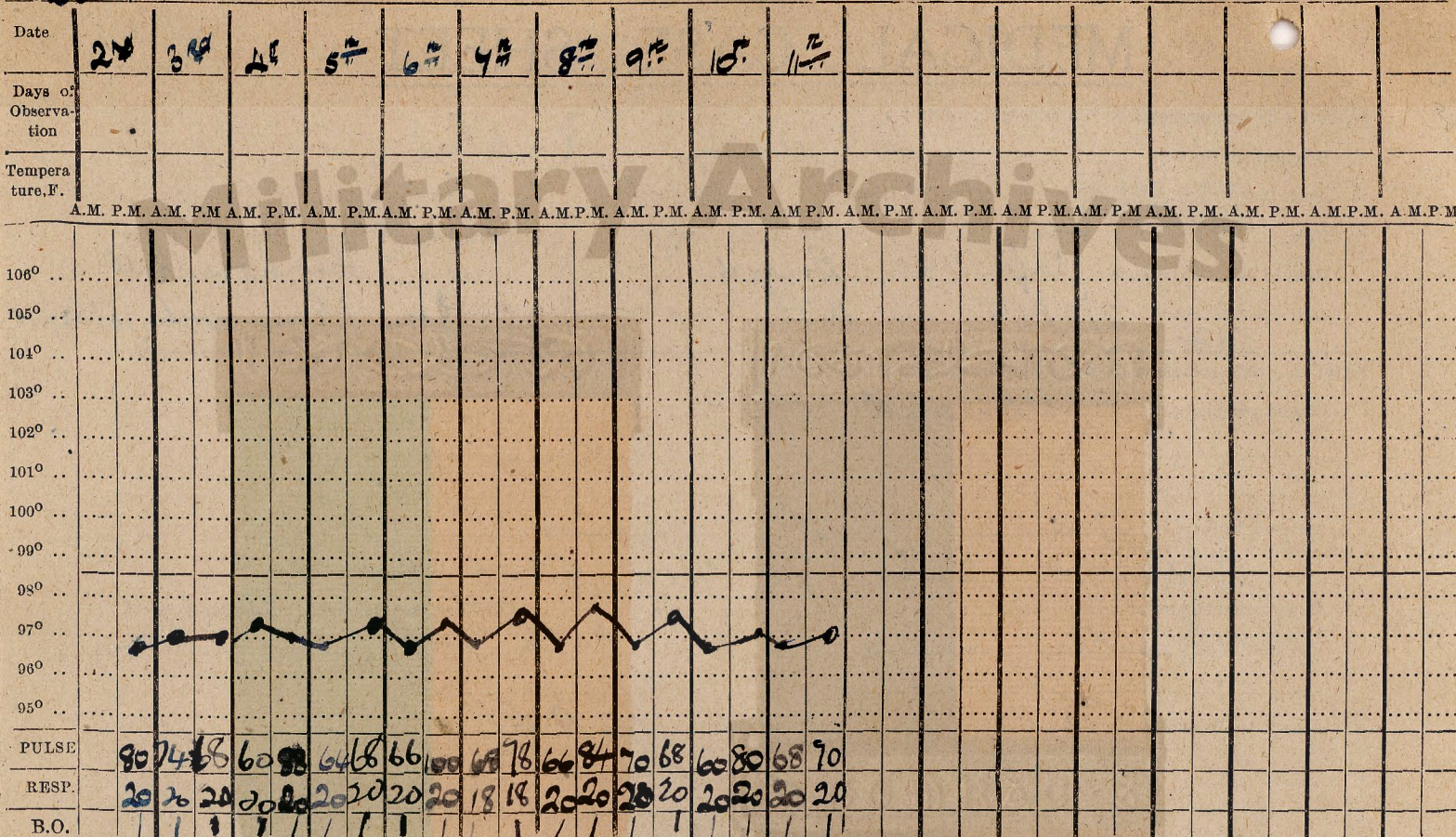
