I am directed by the Minister for Defence to state that an application for a service certificate under the Military Service Pensions Act, 1934, was received from Mr. Frank Aiken, T.D. in 1936. Mr. Aiken withdrew his application by letter dated the 23rd September, 1942, before the Referee had reported on the claim. He recently intimated that he wishes to proceed with his application.

In view of the Attorney General's opinion in the case of Mr. Gerald Boland, T.D., 102, Howth Road, Clontarf, Dublin, (Your ref. P.20/18/54) Mr. Aiken's application was referred to the Referee for investigation. The Referee has reported that Mr. Aiken is a person to whom the Military Service Pensions Act, 1934, applies and a service certificate under Section 10 (2) of the Act, based on the findings of the Referee as contained in his report which is attached, has accordingly been granted to him.

The Minister now proposes, with the sanction of the Minister for Finance, and in accordance with the terms of Section 11 of the Act to grant Mr. Frank Aiken, T.D., Dun Gaoithe, Sandford, Co. Dublin, a pension, the details of which are as follows:-

- (a) a certificate of military service or a service certificate has been issued to any person, and
- (b) the Minister is required by the immediately preceding Section to revoke or amend such certificate,

the Minister shall send by registered post, addressed to such person at his last known residence, a notice requiring such person to send such certificate to the Minister within such time after the service of such notice as may be specified in such notice.

- (2) If any person upon whom a notice under this Section has been served fails to comply with such notice, such person shall be guilty of an offence under this Section, and shall be liable on summary conviction thereof to a fine not exceeding ten pounds and a further fine not exceeding one pound for every day during which such offence is continued.

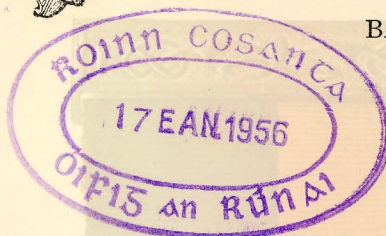

Section 20 (1) of the Mil. Ser. Pensions Act, 1934, defines Public Moneys as—"Any remuneration, pension, or allowance payable out of public moneys, whether provided by the Oireachtas or out of the Central Fund or by means of the poor rate or any other rate imposed by a local authority.

Extract from Mil. Ser. Pensions Act, 1934, Section 19 (1) & (2)—"If any person with a view to obtaining either for himself or any other person a grant or payment of a pension under this Act, makes, signs or uses any declaration, application or other written statement knowing the same to be false, such person shall be guilty of an offence under this section, and shall be liable, on summary conviction thereof to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds, or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or at the discretion of the Court to both such fine and imprisonment.

If any person so convicted as aforesaid is in receipt of a pension obtained by reason of such false declaration, application, or other written statement he shall forfeit such pension as from the date of such conviction."

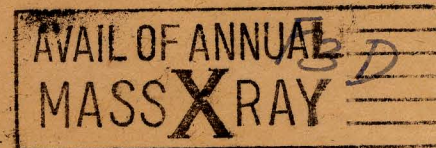
