

the re-investigation of his application under the Military Service Pensions Act, 1934 has reported that in accordance with the provisions of Section II (1) (i) of the Military Service Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1949 he is not of opinion that there is a prima facie case that the applicant is a person to whom the Act of 1934 applies and must, therefore, refuse to reinvestigate the application.
The Referee states, however, that his decision is governed by the fact that the applicant appears to be a person to whom the Act of 1924 applies. The applicant has now submitted an application under this Act together with an explanation as to why he did not apply within the statutory time limit.
