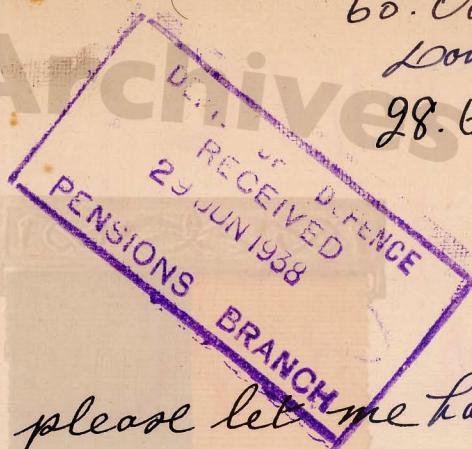

I would be very grateful to you Dear Sir, if you will please do something for me about the pension and medal as I have five children. My eldest son has joined the army I have one boy and girl idle. Again thanking you for the 1916 medal.




