

I am very sorry to learn that you are not feeling well and that things are in such a bad way with you.

meeting you in Paris in 1926 and helping you to get Mr MacDowell into an hotel and with your travelling arrangements and certainly at the time I understood that he was suffering from severe illness contracted while in prison from which the doctors held out no hope of his recovery. I think you knew at the time yourself that your effort to get him to the South of France was rather a desperate last chance from which there was little hope. I had great admiration for the courage with which you were both bearing the situation and I have no doubt that your husband's early death was due to his services in the National movement.
