The award then made to you could, on application by you, have been reconsidered within a period of five years from the date of the award, but as you of course know you made no such application. There is now no legal authority to review the award at this stage and it would not be possible to alter that position under the present Bill without opening the door to all cases such as yours. I regret that a step of that nature would not be justified.
