FIRST SCHEDULE.

RULES FOR DETERMINING NOTIONAL GRADES OF RANK IN THE FORCES HELD BY PERSONS SERVING IN THE FORCES.

- 1.—(1) Any person who at any date was either Chief of Staff, Deputy Chief of Staff, Adjutant General, a Divisional Officer Commanding, or Quartermaster General shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank A.
 - (2) Any person who at any date was either-
 - (a) a General Headquarters Officer acting as Director of any one of the following services, namely Organisation, Intelligence, Engineering and Munitions, or
 - (b) a Brigade Officer Commanding whose brigade was at that date not less than one thousand in strength,

shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank B.

- (3) Any person who at any date was either-
 - (a) a Brigade Officer Commanding whose brigade at that date was less than one thousand in strength, or
 - (b) a Divisional Vice Officer Commanding, or
 - (c) a Divisional Adjutant, or
 - (d) a Divisional Quartermaster, or
 - (e) a Battalion Commandant whose battalion was at that date not less than three hundred in strength, or
 - (f) a Brigade Vice Officer Commanding whose brigade was at that date not less than one thousand in strength, or
 - (g) a Brigade Adjutant whose brigade was at that date not less than one thousand in strength, or
 - (h) a Brigade Quartermaster whose brigade was at that date not less than one thousand in strength, or
 - (i) a Column Commander whose column was at that date not less than thirty in strength, or
 - (j) a General Headquarters Officer who at that date was acting as Director of Medical Services, or
 - (k) a General Headquarters Officer who at that date was acting as Director of any Service, other than that of Medical Services, or one of the Services mentioned in sub-paragraph (a) of the immediately preceding paragraph,

shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank C.

- (4) A person who at any date-
 - (a) was a Battalion Commandant whose battalion at that date was less than three hundred in strength, or
 - (b) was a Company Captain whose company at that date was not less than sixty in strength, or
 - (c) was, at that date, a Captain on the General Headquarters Staff or on a Divisional Staff, or
 - (d) was, in the case of a company which at that date was not less than one hundred and twenty in strength, where the company had at that date one Lieutenant only, such Lieutenant or, where the company had at that date two Lieutenants only, one or other of such Lieutenants, or, where the company had at that date three or more Lieutenants, one or other of the two Lieutenants who were at that date respectively second and third in command or
 - (e) was, in the case of a company which at that date was less than one hundred and twenty in strength but not less than one hundred in strength, where such company had at that date one Lieutenant only, such Lieutenant or where such company had at that date two or more Lieutenants, the Lieutenant who was at that date second in command, or
 - (f) was a Brigade Officer, other than a Brigade Officer who is deemed by virtue of paragraph (2) or (3) of this Rule to have held at that date either Rank B or Rank C, or
 - (g) was a Battalion Vice Officer Commanding whose battalion at that date was not less than one hundred in strength, or
 - (h) was a Battalion Adjutant whose battalion was at that date not less than one hundred in strength, or

shall be deemed for the purposes of this Act to have held at that date Rank E.

- (6) Any person who at any date held the rank of non-commissioned officer or private shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank E.
- (7) None of the foregoing provisions of this Rule shall apply to any person who at any date was a member of Fianna Eireann or of Cumann na mBan and was not at any date a member of Oglaigh na hEireann (Irish Republican Army) or of the Irish Volunteers, and in lieu thereof the following provisions shall have effect in relation to any such person, that is to say:—
 - (a) any person who at any date:-
 - (i) was a member of the headquarters staff or executive of Fianna Eireann or Cumann na mBan, or
 - (ii) was an officer of Fianna Eireann or Cumann na mBan commanding one hundred members or more of either of those bodies, or
 - (iii) was an officer of Fianna Eireann or Cumann na mBan senior to an officer of either of those bodies commanding one hundred members or more of either of those bodies,

shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank D, and

- (b) any person who at any date was a member of Fianna Eireann or Cumann na mBan and who is not deemed by virtue of the foregoing sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph to have held Rank D, shall be deemed to have held at that date Rank E.
- 2. Where an officer whose grade of rank at any date is, under Rule I of this Schedule, to be determined both by his actual rank in the Forces and the strength of the unit to which he belonged at that date, and such officer is, at that date, absent from duty by reason of imprisonment on account of his activities as a member of the Forces, the following provisions shall, for the purposes of the said Rule I, have effect in relation to such officer, that is to say:—
 - (a) such officer shall be deemed to have held at that date the actual rank in the Forces which he held at the date of his arrest, and
 - (b) such unit shall be deemed to be at that date at the same strength as it was at the time of his arrest.
- 3. Where the case of any person does not fall within the provisions of Rule I of this Schedule, the Referee may determine the particular grade of rank which such person is to be deemed to have held on any date, and in so determining the Referee shall have regard to the following matters, that is to say:—
 - (a) the appointment held by such person,
 - (b) the services performed by such person,
 - (c) the principles of grading set forth in the said Rule I.
- 4. Where any person, whose case at a particular date falls within the provisions of Rule I of this Schedule, was, at that date, engaged in service of a special character, the Referee may, in making his report under this Act in relation to the grade of rank held by such person on such date, report that the grade of rank held by him on such date is a grade of rank higher than the grade which, but for this Rule, would be the grade of rank held by him on that date.

DEFINITION OF THE FIRST AND SECOND CRITICAL DATES.

1. In the case of a person who served in the Forces during the period commencing on the 1st day of July, 1922, and ending on the 30th day of September, 1923,

The expression "the first critical date" means the 11th day of July, 1921; and the expression "the second critical date" means:—

2. In the case of a person who did not serve in the Forces during the period commencing on the 1st day of July, 1922, and ending on the 30th day of September, 1923, but who has either:—

(a) served in the Forces at any time during the week commencing on the 23rd day of April, 1916, or

(b) served in the Forces continuously during the period commencing on the 1st day of April, 1921, and ending on the 11th day of July, 1921,

the expression "the first critical date" shall be construed as meaning the date during the said week, or if he did not serve during the said week, during the said period, on which he first served in the Forces in such week or such period (as the case may be), and

the expression "the second critical date" shall be construed as meaning the earliest date in the period between the first critical date in respect of such person, and the 12th day of July, 1921, on which such person held his highest rank in such last-mentioned period in the Forces.

SWORN STATEMENT OF RICHARD HICKEY (No. 20873) MADE BEFORE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON THE 1st of NOVEMBER 1937. Q. "C" Company, 3rd Battalion? A. Yes. Q. Did you bring any references with you? A. Only the ones on the form and one I have got here. (Reference handed in). Q. When aid you join? A. In the Rotunda in 1913. Q. Were you mobilised on Easter Sunday? 1st period A. Yes. Q. And it was called off? A. Yes. Q. Where did you spend the rest of the day? A. At home. Q. Were you 'standing to'? A. Yes. We were instructed to remain ready. Q. At home day and night. On Monday were you mobilised again? A. Yes. Q. Where did you parade? A. At Camden Row, Long Lane at the Battalion Open Air Headquarters. Q. Where did you go then to the Post? A. On the journey down with the Battalion Commandant, Commandant O'Connor, he came to me and said to give my rifle to another man and to take a bicycle and return to Portobello Bridge and just watch the barracks. Q. How long were you watching the barracks there? A. Until about 4 o'clock. Q. Where did you go then? A. I could not see anyone to anyone to tell me what I was to do and as I lived a few yards away I went in and had some food. Q. Where did you go then? A. I went in the direction of Portobello Road, where the Commandant had told me to move off, and I did not find anyone I knew, and I met a fellow whom I had known in Liverpool, who told me to go to Larkfield, Kimmage to see if I could find my corwd. I went there and remained in Larkfield until the night. I did not know the crowd. Q. Where did you go then? A. We then went to the G.P.O. carrying arms and some stuff.

Q. When did you go into the G.P.O.?

A. About 1.30 in the morning. We carried all supplies, shot gun ammunition.

Q. Did you stay in the G.P.O. garrison then?
A. I remained in the G.P.O. I was brought down to the centre hall and they inquired what Battalion Tobelonged to, and I was given over to the Section Leader.

Q. Did you get arms?

A. Yes - not my own rifle which was taken from me by the Commandant.

Q. How long did you remain in the G.P.O?

- A. Until the surrender. I was at Princes' Street and afterwards removed to Henry Street and Moore Street.
- Q. You were not sent out to any other post from that?
 A. No. We went down to Henry Street and Moore Lane and
 I went to a Mineral Water Store.
- Q. Were you in the surrender?
- A. Yes. We were taken out to our barricade and afterwards we worked through Moore Street by boring through the wall.
- Q. Where did you spend Saturday night?
- A. At the rink in front of the Rotunda Hospital.
- Q. Are you on the 'Roll of Honour' for Easter Week?
 A. I never applied. I do not belong to any organisation.

- Q. Three weeks before Easter Week Where were you then? A. I was in Dublin.
- Q. Working at your ordinary job?
- A. Yes, at my trade as Cabinetmaker.
- Q. Would you have been called to do anything very special during that period before the Rising?
- A. It was just parades and drills. I was an ordinary volunteer.
- Q. You did not spend any time out at Larkfield?
- A. Except the ordinary parades, musketry practice and battalion drilling.
- Q. On the Sunday after the Rising you were a prisoner -
- where were you taken?
 A. To Richmond barracks from the Rotunda.
- Q. And where else?
- A. And from Richmond barracks I was out on the first batch to Knutsford gaol.
- Q. Were you released from Knutsford?
- A. From Frongoch after coming before the tribunal.
- Q. When were you released?
- A. At the General Release when the gaol was cleared out. It was Christmas Eve.

Q. You did not take any further part?
A. I attended the parades after I returned for a period.

Q. Until when?

- A. I suppose about for six months I cannot recollect very well. There was serious illness in my family then to prevent me from doing so.
- Q. Were you interned in Ballykinlar?
- Yes. There was a raid on which they found documents, and I was brought to Portobello barracks.
- Q. When were you arrested again?
- A. It was the 25th January, 1921.
- Q. When did they let you out of Ballykinlar?
- A. At the Truce.
- Q. How many months had you been in Ballykinlar? A. About nine months it might be more.

- Q. Was it August or December you were released? A. I think it was towards the end of the year.
- Q. Was the Treaty signed?
 A. Yes. I think it was when the Treaty was signed I was I was there when Tadh Barry was shot - it was after that.
- Q. You were released then about December?
- A. It would be about that.
- Q. Were you a member of the volunteers up to the date of your arrest?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Or had you dropped out of them?
- A. I think I had ceased parading or being called on for official parades before that. I could not actually say how long after I came back after the 1916 period I was on parades. For a considerable time after that I was on parade and took a fresh Oath of Allegiance.
- Q. When you were arrested were you a member of the Volunteers?
- No, I suppose. I was never actually under orders. I think I could say I was not on the list for being called up as a Volunteer. A. No, I suppose.
- Q. Were you a volunteer?
- A. No. On the first form I sent in, Mr. Frank Thornton was in the G.P.O. and he knew me in the Liverpool company, and he asked me would I come out to the Imperial Hotel and I told him I was told off to go on to the landing, and he said in that case it was alright. He would be available for references to the fact that I was present in the G.P.O., and also Mr. Foley.
