Section 2(3) of the Military Service Pensions Acts 1924 and 1925 reads as follows:-

The Minister may in his absolute discretion refuse to issue a certificate of military service to any applicant who shall have, prior to the making of the report by the Board of Assessors, been sentenced by a court of competent jurisdiction in Saorstát Éireann to suffer imprisonment with or without hard labour for any term exceeding three months or any term of penal servitude.

The Board of Assessors have reported in favour of the grant of certificates to the persons mentioned overleaf. With a view to the application of the section quoted above to their cases I am to request that you will be so good as to furnish overleaf particulars of any sentences to imprisonment with or without hard labour in excess of three months or to penal servitude for any term passed by any court since the 6th December 1921.

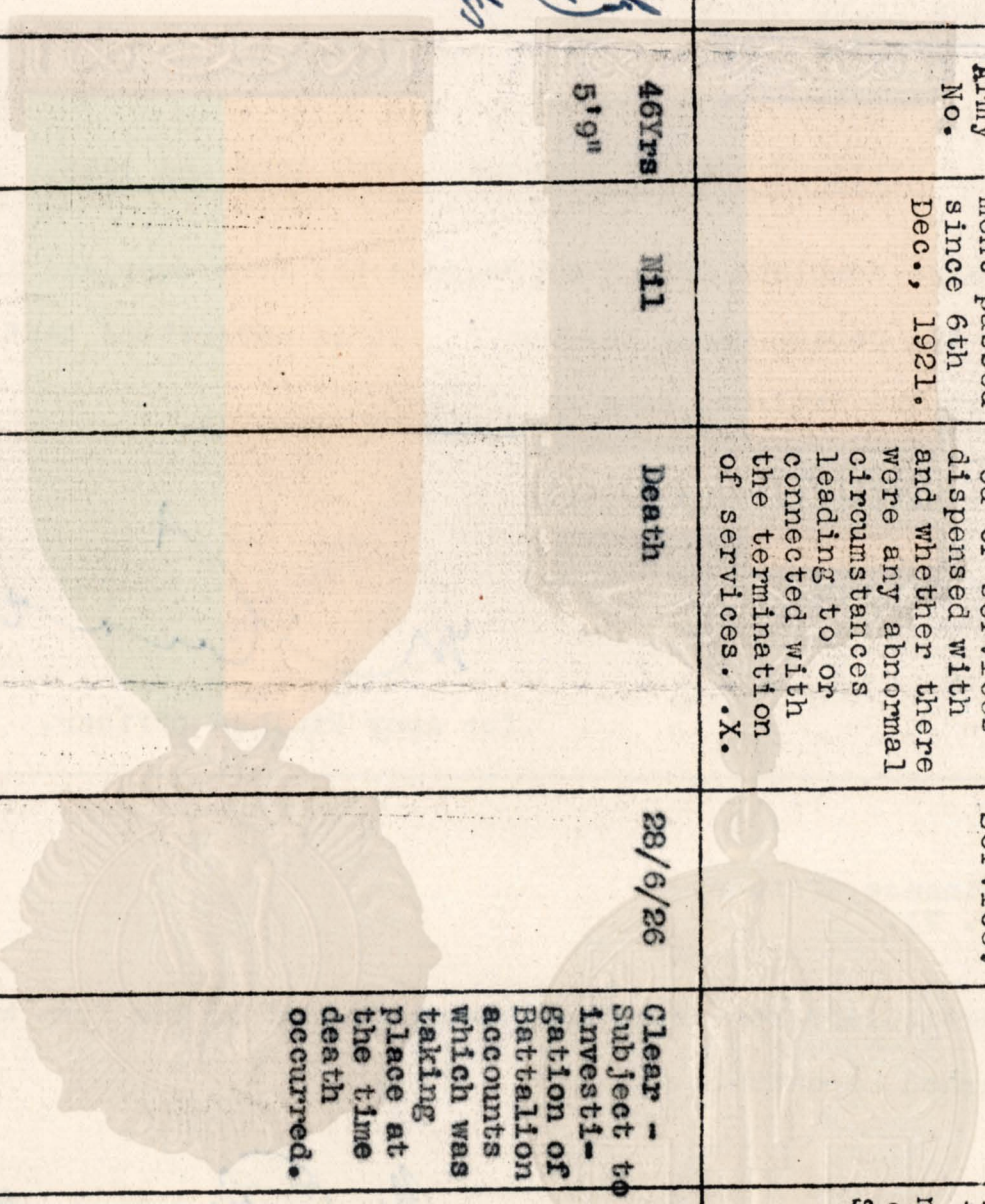
