Report as to dependency of Applicant or of the motherless children upon Deceased at the time of his death.

The Civic Guard report states that the applicant, James Cleary, father of deceased Capt. Michael Cleary, did not enjoy any private income prior to death of deceased beyond the produce of a farm of 40 acres of poor land in Middleline, Mountshannon. (Valuation 221:15:0).

The nett profit of farm would be hard to ascertain-owing to economic conditions the farm is at present scarcely paying.

The applicant is 70 yrs. and infirm and unable to do any work on the farm.

Deceased was the only son of applicant and Kate Cleary, aged 71 yrs. who is also living and dependent on produce of farm.

Up to time of joining the National Army deceased worked on the farm and managed same generally for the applicant. Deceased was then 25 yrs. and in good health.

When deceased joined the Army paid labour had to be hired by the applicant, reducing the profits of the farm considerably. The applicant in my opinion was totally dependent on deceased and his death has been an irreparable loss to the applicant.

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
