Ho records of Gariow Biomna were submitted to the Reforee for the purposes of the 1934. Act, and noboay got a pension unier cither the 1924 or the 1934 .ct in repgect of pre-lruce Carlo riama nemberahip.
Fiowever, se have a record of sive applications under the 1924 Act in reapect of such memberahipe They were from -
(1) Peter P o'paryell (2hsp/5683) the claimed to have been pro-rruce Battalion $0, \mathrm{C}$, of the ist Battalion, Cariow Dianna and also (oimultoneous 1 y ) a pre-Fruce mamber of the Volunteers. The I,R.A. Brigode I.O. . Superintendent 8. Stack pre him quasisted verification -with the addendum "Carzom was not ray warzike", and General Hugo Heveill stated that be had come in contrets with him in the Firma before the critical perici. The soard of Assessors eredited urp o Paycil with non-pensionable Fianna coulcos the enitical period, He has since disappersed syin the scone - deccased or left the country.
(2) Prank Hutton ( $2451 / 7043$ ) who claimed to have been prem Truce $x$ reurenant and Captain of A (Carlow Company) 1st Battalion Pianna, superintenảent stack did not know him, but F.F. o'parsil verified for him as a Lieutenant and also as to his having moriced with the Voluntecrs. There rere other Fianna and $1 . R$ of. verifications, and the Board of issessors ereas ted him with non-pertionable Pianna service for the critical period.
(3) John If Nalah (243F/3467) who claimea pre-Trucc nombership of $A$ company; cariow plama. fio receivea a qualified verification from PoP. O'Farveis - "not a very ucestui member", and was also verified by carda Peter Branegan, who described himself as Pianna Battalion Majutont. There were other I, ReA, and pioma priftcations and the Boord credited him wi th non-pensionable Fianna service for the critical period. Ho is nom dead.
(4) penis HOGAN (OHse/4593) who cialmed pre-ryuce mombership or Copeny fariow Flanas, He got verificatione from PoP. OF Fascois and Peter branagh. The Board crealted his with nen-gensionable Fianna service for the critical periob.
(5) Tamas Bice (24sp/109), whe ciaimed pre-muce nemberahis of Capiow Ficuma. Ho was verified by Peter Branagan and also gave fop. o'Farsell as a roference, but the verification Pown seems to have been sent to mother officer of the same nome pho roplied that he ald not know the applicant. Poasibly on that account, the Board did not credit him with itewrucc semice, ponionabie or non-pensionabie.
Nob, $2,3,4$ and. 5 were awarded Hedals under the old mytion of investication. It has always been the practice to perand thic findin of the board of Asseasoys (and of the 1.932 Not Hillitary Sevvice Registration Board) as beyond question the the matter of cortification of pre-riuce service, both being statutory bodies, so that, evin
though there were no 1934, Act recopas of Carlon Bianaa, the Medals in cases 2,3 and 4 wero heid dury avapaed when the holders applied for benefita - 2 and 4 for free tivavel and 3 for a epecial allowance. In case 5, the modat was held not dut, avaraed for free travel purpeses because of the absence of 2934 Act records or of a Board of Assesecre centificate. Tha peraon in question - Jemes Rice - is appealing againat that decision.
Peter Branagan, reforsed to abova as ane of the rerifiors, ayplied Por a pengion tuder the $193^{4}$ Act, deseribing himself as prestruce Compeny (not Battalion) Aafutany Casci Company Fionnae His application was unsuccessrul whe Referee and Aavisory Comittee, whike the Board of Aasessors, did not concern themselves with certifying nonopunsionable sezvice.

Er. Branagan received a Medal under the old eystem on the certification of the piame Aaytacy Doarde When he apylied Por sree travel, the Hean was hele not dury awarice purpuont to the "general uinisterial decialone tie has not epnealed, al thouth be expreseca himsels athorigiy in a Ietter of it th october, 1969 to another applicent, Denia Comolis (uw 25399).
On looking through all the filcs of those who aypiled for tredals in respect of memberahty of capicm jianna, a feetwe which energes is the frequent mention of Hessys. OParril and Branagen as offlcers. Frank Buttion is selacm mentioned and in his om Hedal application he says that he was a Plama ofilces for three years
"untri tranafersed to the IoReAp"
It is possible - and indiced likely - that in Carlow, as in other places, the Fiamna had become morlbund of brushed asiac at the critical period, the Fiama officess centinuine to work with the I. $\mathrm{K}_{\mathrm{A}} \mathrm{A}_{\text {. On the other hand, we have, because of the Boarl of }}$ Assessors certiricates, held traals auly awarded in four cases and so have implicitiy accepted the exiatence of a Cempow 3 lanna unit at the critical rericd - in eny event, it would be difficult for us, if challenged on the basis of these cases, to argue otherwise.

Therefore, 1 w111 hold, on balance, that there was such a mito The next question is the resirication of applications. I, $\mathrm{R}_{\mathrm{a}} \mathrm{A}_{0}$. verification aione is not much melp; the oflyturviring, Ioketo, Gcompany ofricer is the o, e, damea bico (no relation of case 5 above). Therorore. I mould propone to accopt Fank zutton and Peter Branagen as Jiame officeso for verificatich purponea.

## This means that, as a first atepio, I must now hola Mre Branagen's Yodat duy amarea. I have done thro on hio oma firye he shoula be friorated ab Give that this bes been dene ss a reaut of further investigation, and shoula also be given whatoves mee teraves or other concessions for which he has anked and is clisible,

Apter this has been aonc, the two appeal cases ahould be dealt with Jomes Rice and Denis Comnoliy. Verirication forms should be sett to Mcasx, Hutten and Branagen - there is already verification from the I.R.H, Compary $0 . \mathrm{C}_{4}$. If they verify, Hr, R1ce's Hedai may be hela duny awarded and the yedal may be arrarded to wro Comolly. is regaras Mr. Comroily'a file, it is as rell to record that all thoge 1isted on the back of his ayplication form, with the creention of Frank Futton, were $1, R_{0} A_{4}$, not $\bar{H}$ lama, and thet, desp 1 te that is saic by was. Intton in her lettor of $24 / 9 / 69$, there are no pensions being paid in Cariow in respect of Fianna memberahip.

As regaras 211 the other cares, wo should await appoais which Wi.11 no doubt come - In some Instances, onyhow, If they do, the eancs should be deant with in the same way. I should like to be kegt informed of al1 such casas.
