You state that there is no records
of Derry Fianna Eriann. I have never
been asked by your department to supply
any list of Fianna memberships if such
a request was made I never received it.
Fianna Eriann in Derry City was a most
active organisation it trained and prepared the
youth who when they became of age were transferred
to the Irish Volunteers later known as the Irish Republican
Army. The Fianna in Derry City during the
three months ended the 11th Feb. 1921
was one hundred and eighty members
as Fianna H. G. records will show.
