

To Whom It May Concern:

Gentlemen:

I received a letter informing me that your office had written a letter to Keel, Achill, and it was returned to you. I understand that the letter asked for information regarding a Michael Gineley, Dooega, Achill, as to his participation in the I.R.A. during Ireland's fight for freedom.

My first encounter with Mr. Gineley was the formation of the first company of Volunteers in Achill. I recall that when the late Darrel Figgis formed this company of Young Volunteers in that area, Gineley was one of that company. I, myself can assure you that Mr. Gineley was one of the boys that was really active. I know this because I was first Adjutant and Anthony McNamara, now residing in Dooagh, Achill, was first Company Captain. As a member of that company founded in 1914 by Figgis, Gineley was always ready to obey orders anytime he was asked to do so. I suggest that you contact Anthony McNamara to verify this.

I have nothing to gain by this. Mr. Gineley is in Ireland and I am in the United States, but the fact remains that Mr. Gineley did belong to the I.R.A. and the Sinn Fein clubs and did his best. If there are any benefits rendered to Ex-I.R.A. men, I most certainly say that under such a law Mr. Gineley is entitled to his just reward.
