

Please send me as soon as possible a form of petition for Service Pensions Act Coman na-MBan.

I applied before in 1936 & was rejected so I never appealed it.

I was a good active member of the Coman na-MBan from 1917 to 1923. And helped the boys on the run every way I possibly could. As I had the greatest sympathy for them all along & never changed my views yet.

I am enclosing a reference from my first cousin who sent this from America in 1938. She lived beside me in the same village ~~then~~ ^{during the trouble} And her dear brother Staff Captain Jim Moran was killed in action in the Glenhest Mountains in Active Service 1921.

This leaflet is the only thing I have to show that I applied before in 1936.
