MILITARY SERVICE PENSIONS ACTS. 34/53754

I, Bridget O'Malley of High Street, Westport, HEREBY apply to have my application under the Military Service Pensions Act reopened on the following ground :-

1. My maiden name was Bridget Donoghue and during the Anglo-Irish War I was resident in Tourmakeady and was a member of the Tourmakeady Cumann Na Mban Company. I attach hereto a statement of my service.

2. In addition to the evidence already submitted I would stress the following : I was on active service under fire at Tourmakeady Ambush and assisted in carrying Thomas Maguire who was wounded there to safety. I was attending him and nursing him and guarding him subsequently.

3. I would ask that my application be ~~considered~~^{considered} in conjunction with the other Tourmakeady women whose applications are pending before the Board. Mr. Maguire formerly refused to testify before the Board but has now agreed to certify as to our service in that area. Mr. Maguire was the only man who was really familiar with our work and it would be impossible ~~xxx~~ ~~xxx~~ to do justice to our claims without having the benefit of his evidence. In addition to Mr. Maguire's evidence the following can also testify to my services - Eamonn Meane, Carrowbaun, Westport; Liam Rabbett of Quay Road, Westport; Mrs Costello Gortnacullen, Tourmakeady.

4. I make this declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the Statute of Declarations Act 1938

DECLARE at Westport in the County of Mayo, this 29 day of Dec 1945, before me a Peace Commissioner in and for said County of Mayo, by Bridget O'Malley who is personally known to me.

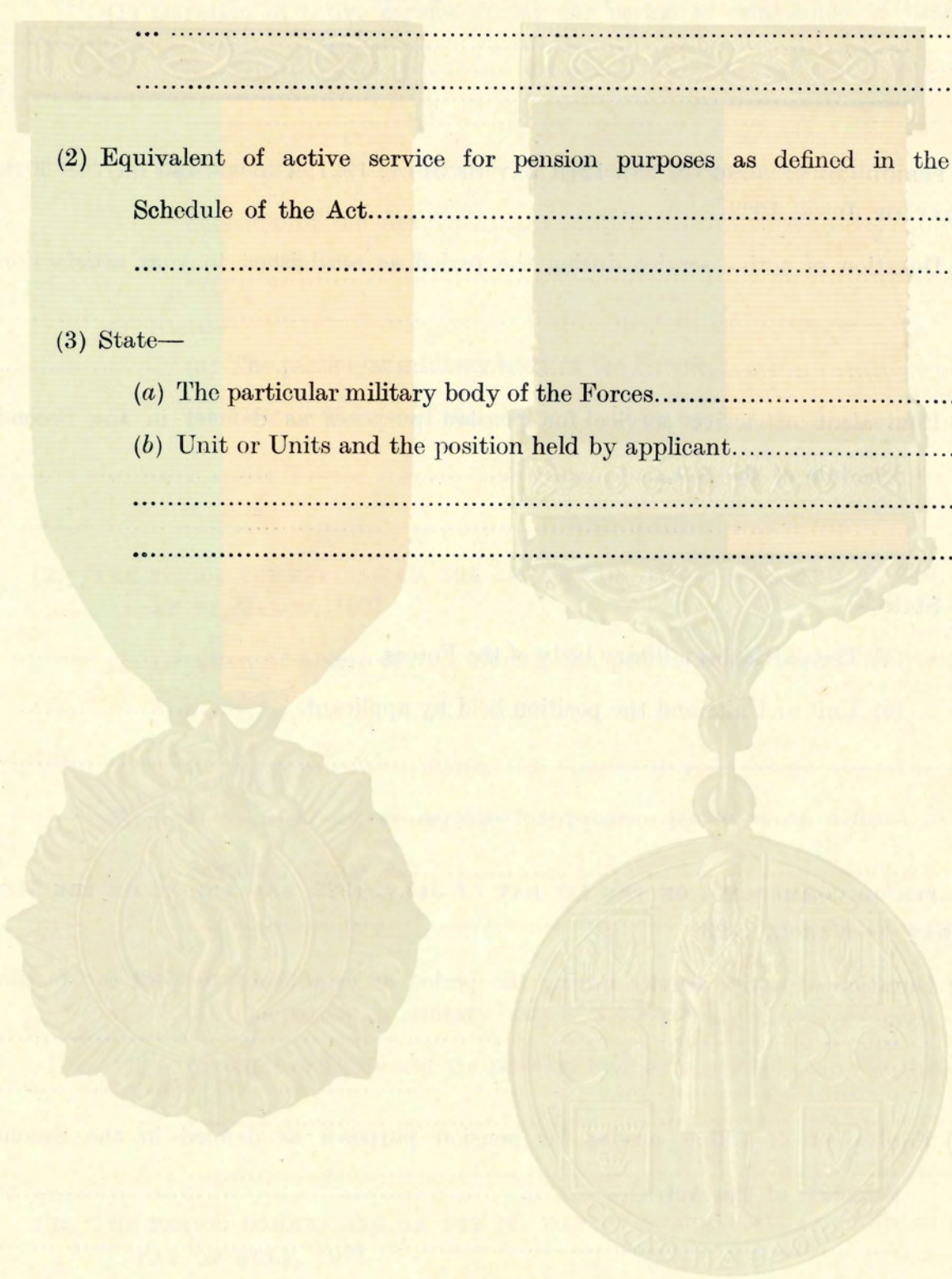
