Sometime ago I made application for Service Medal and Certificate to which I am convinced I am perfectly entitled, and in reply from the Secretary, Roinn Cosanta Brainnse Airgeadais no. 34/S.P./60720 I was refused.

I cannot understand this Refusal as I produced evidence and documents to show that I was a member of Cumann na mBen (from 1917 to the Cease Fire order) carried dispatches looked after discharged prisoners and suffered a term of internment under the Cumann na Gaedheal Government thro' which I lost my health and I am drawing a Disability Pension granted by Hainna Sail Govmt.

I see people here who received the Service Medal + Certificate who did very little when work was to be done. I intended raising the matter in a general sense at the present Ard Theis to which I was appointed a delegate. Illness however ^{has} prevented me from attending and I think it best to

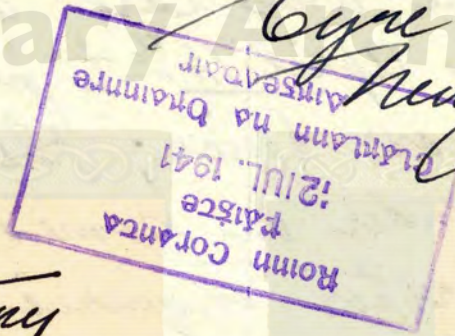

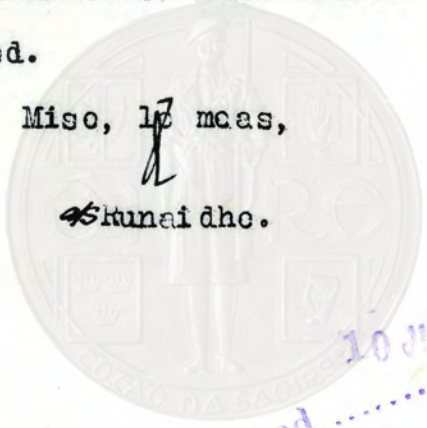
