5. Urinalysis report.
6. State if in opinion of examining doctor the applicant is incapable of self-support by reason of permanent infirmity.

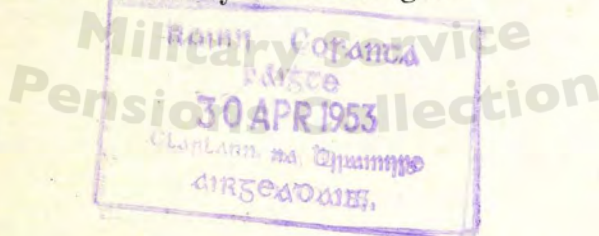
