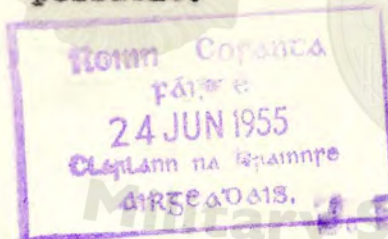

With reference to the representations of the Minister for Lands on behalf of Miss Winnie O'Malley, Arderry, Aughagower, Westport, Co. Mayo, the Minister for Defence desires me to say that the statutory time limit for the acceptance of completed forms of application under the Military Service Pensions Acts, from persons who had not previously applied, expired on the 18th March, 1955.

As the Minister has no discretionary power under the Acts to accept an application after the expiration of the statutory time limit it is regretted that no action is possible in the matter and no useful purpose would be served by issuing an application form to Miss O'Malley at this stage.
