With reference to your letter of 29th April 1975, I am directed by the Minister for Defence to state that the late Lt.-Col. Paul was in receipt of a Military Service Pension, a disability pension and retired pay. The balance of retired pay due for the period 1st to 26th April 1975 (the date of death) is £85.37. As the Military Service Pension and disability pension warrants for April were both issued for lodgment to the deceased's account with the Bank of Ireland, O'Connell Street, Dublin 1 and as both warrants were paid by this Department an overpayment of £29.57 has occurred, (Military Service Pension £6.06, disability pension £23.51). This amount is being deducted from the balance of retired pay due, leaving a net balance of £55.80 due to the estate.

Consideration will be given to the payment of this balance (subject to any deductions which may be necessary in respect of income tax etc.) to the legal personal representative of the deceased on production at this office of the original Grant of Probate.

A funeral grant of £50 is also payable.

Pensions Act, 1924, Section 7 (1) & (2) - "If any person with a view to obtaining either for himself or any other person a grant or payment of a pension under this Act, makes, signs or uses any declaration, application or other written statement knowing the same to be false, such person shall be guilty of an offence under this section, and shall be liable, on summary conviction thereof, to a fine not exceeding twenty-five pounds, or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding six months, or at the discretion of the Court to both such fine and imprisonment.

If any person so convicted as aforesaid is in receipt of a pension obtained by reason of such false declaration, application, or other written statement he shall forfeit such pension as from the date of such conviction".

N.B. - This Certificate is no security whatever for debt. It should be carefully preserved, as it will be of the greatest assistance to you when completing the Pension Warrants, which will be sent to you.

* In the event of the death of the person to whom this Form is addressed, the person who notifies the death to the local Registrar of Deaths should deliver this Form and any other Pension papers held by deceased, to him, and will receive from him the sum of one shilling for so doing.


