I wish to apply for a pre-Truce Service Medal. All particulars of my record in the I. R. A. since the early days have already been supplied in my application for Service Pension, but I was notified on 10th. January, 1942, (Ref.No.34/SP 24656) that in accordance with Section 8 (1) of the Act, that the Act did not apply to me.

From December, 1920, I filled the positions of Brigade Director of Signalling, and later for a short time Director of Organization and Vice-Brigadier etc. - this was prior to the Truce. During this time I was also imprisoned for several weeks as from 15th. April, 1921, returning to service on release.

I am now at the above address having left the Castle Hotel, and am practising as Dispensary Doctor here.

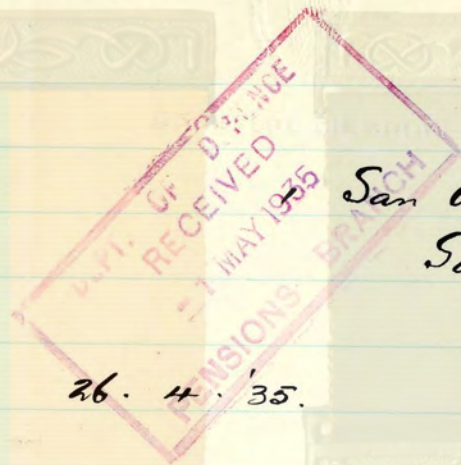
