With reference to your letter of the 14th March ^{last} regarding your application under the Military Service Pensions Acts, I am directed by the Minister for Defence to inform you that the statutory time limit for the acceptance of petitions for the re-investigation, under the terms of the Military Service Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1949, of rejected applications under the Military Service Pensions Acts, 1924 and 1934, expired on the 18th September, 1953.

As the Minister has no discretionary power to accept a petition after the expiration of the statutory time limit it is regretted that no action can now be taken in the matter and no useful purpose would be served by issuing a form of petition to you.
