Dear Tom

I wish to refer to your representations on behalf of Mrs. Mary Flynn, Leaside, Caherslee, Tralee, Co. Kerry, concerning her entitlement to an allowance in respect of her deceased husband, John.

The Army Pensions Act 1980 provides for the payment of an allowance to the widows of special allowance holders who are not otherwise entitled to an allowance under the Army Pensions Acts. As the widow of a Military Service Pensioner, Mrs. Flynn is already in receipt of an allowance under the Army Pensions Act 1971 and I regret, therefore, that she is not eligible for a further allowance under the 1980 Act.

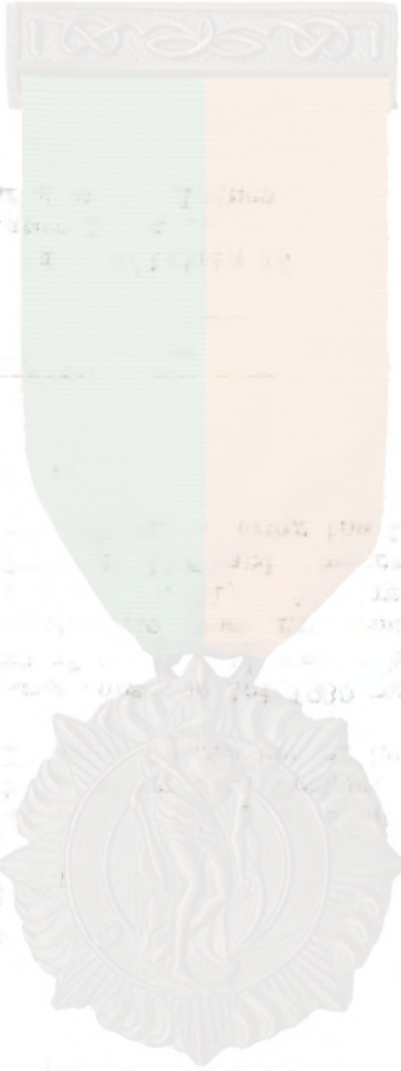

Dear Tom,

I wish to refer to your representations on behalf of Mrs Mary Flynn, Leaside, Caberseele, Tralee, concerning her entitlement to an allowance in respect of her deceased husband, John.

The Army Pensions Act, 1980 provides for the grant of an allowance to the widow of a special allowance holder, provided she is not already in receipt of, or entitled to, any other award under the Army Pensions Acts. The late Mr. Flynn never applied for a special allowance; he was, however, the holder of a military service pension and in consequence, Mrs Flynn was awarded an allowance under the Army Pensions Act, 1971. As outlined above, she is precluded from benefiting further under the Acts.
