I wish to draw your attention to my claim for a Gratuity. as I suffered through my patriotism as much as anybody. I was a member of the Liverpool Police untill 1915. Rather than fight on the side of the British I Resigned. I was one of the first men in this district to offer my service as a Volunteer to the late Darrell Figgis Prior to the Rising in 1916. I emigrated to England where I became a member of the Irish self-Determination League although not been arrested. I considered one man out of Prison of more service than one million men in prison. I shall be very Greatfull If you are kind enough to Consider my claim. or forward my letter to the proper Quarter. Thanking you most sincerely
