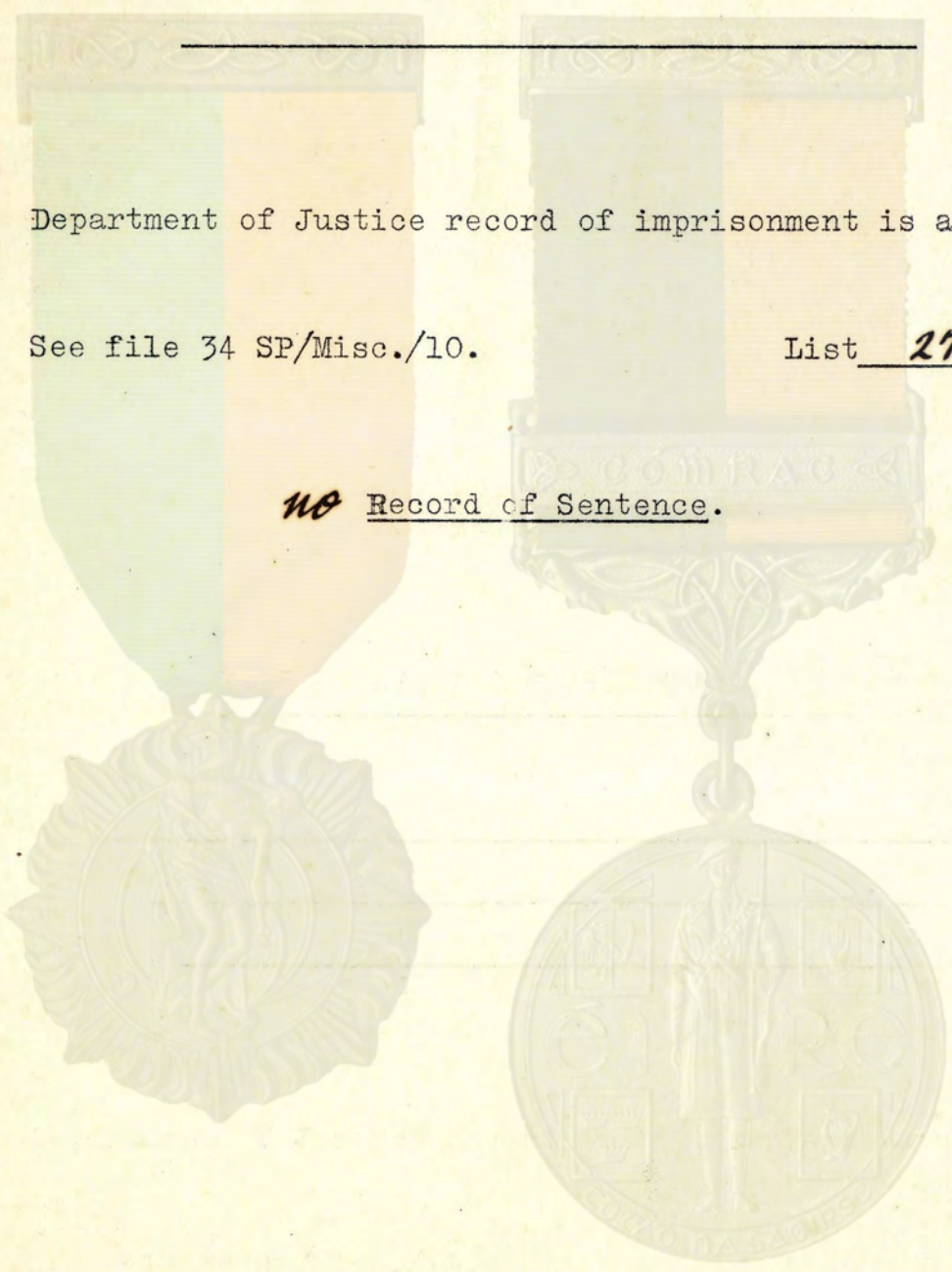

SECTION 14 OF THE MILITARY SERVICE PENSIONS ACT, 1934.

(b) the Minister is required by the immediately preceding Section to revoke or amend such certificate,

the Minister shall send by registered post, addressed to such person at his last known residence, a notice requiring such person to send such certificate to the Minister within such time after the service of such notice as may be specified in such notice.

(2) If any person upon whom a notice under this Section has been served fails to comply with such notice, such person shall be guilty of an offence under this Section, and shall be liable on summary conviction thereof to a fine not exceeding ten pounds and a further fine not exceeding one pound for every day during which such offence is continued.

Consideration will be given to the payment of this balance (subject to any deductions which may be necessary in respect of income tax, etc.) to the legal personal representative of the deceased on production at this office of Probate of Will or Letters of Administration. There is also a grant of £25 payable in respect of funeral expenses. If it is not intended to extract Probate of Will or Letters of Administration, the enclosed form of Statutory Declaration should be completed and returned to this office, together with (1) receipted bills for funeral expenses and (2) Registrar's certificate of death, in order that the question of releasing the balance due may receive attention.

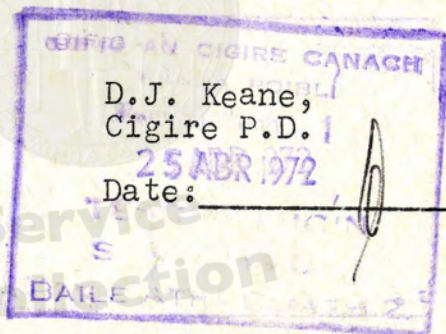
