I must have made a mistake in filling ^{the} form which you sent me, as I have only eight Irish acres of land some of it cut away bog, As you see by the two Medical certificates I sent you that I am no longer fit for work, I will have to let the eight acres in bonacre it will be only worth £32.0.0 per year, If I do not

let it I will have to employ a boy and he will cost me £200. 0. 0 per year, what it would produce would not pay for that

I stated in filling my form that I sold £200. 0. 0 off my land in the year there is what it cost to produce that amount

Pension I was examined by Dr. Little of Galway in Caxelbar Clinic a week ago He is a bone Specialist He is supplying me with a Caumbas jacket for the present and if there is no improvement I will have to go under an operation for my spine which is very serious

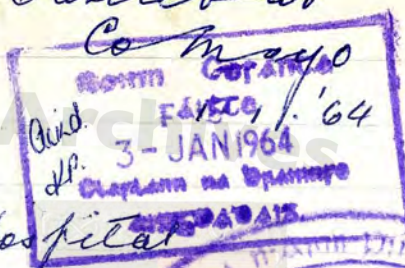

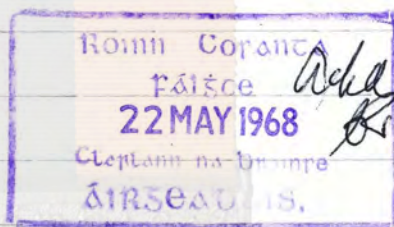
