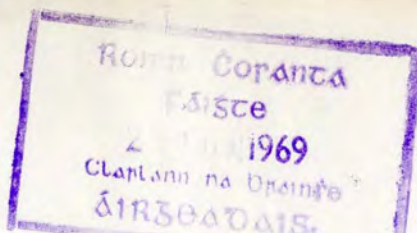

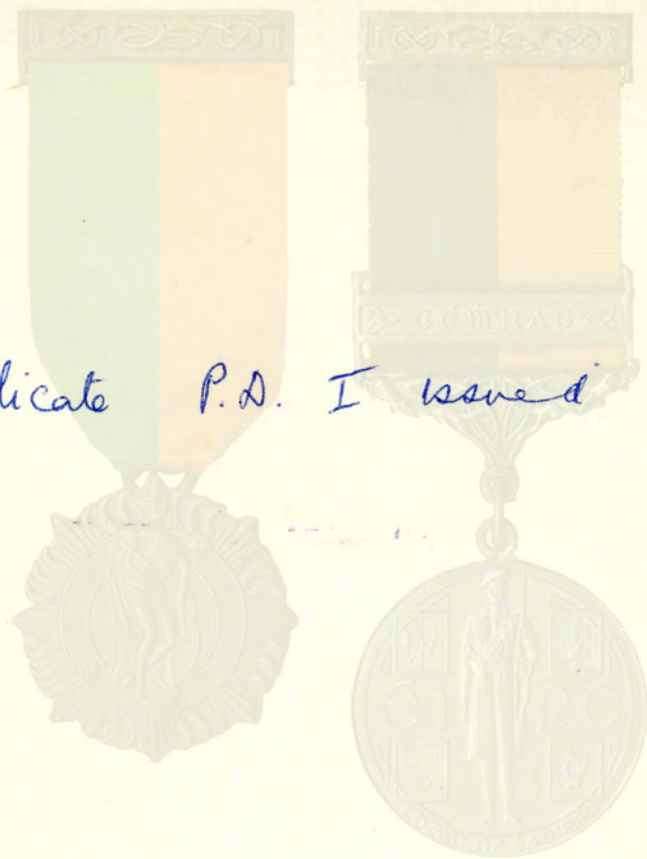

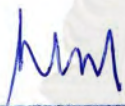

With reference to your recent letter regarding a reduction in your special allowance under the Army Pensions Acts, I am directed by the Minister for Defence to state that a special allowance is an annual sum of such amount as when added to the applicant's yearly means, which for the purpose of a special allowance include his wife's means, will not equal or exceed a prescribed sum. 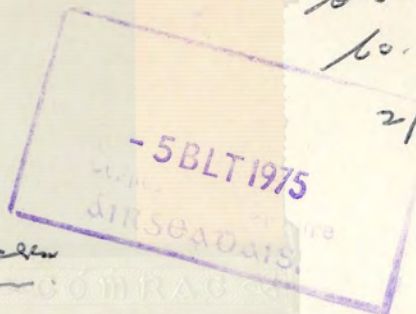

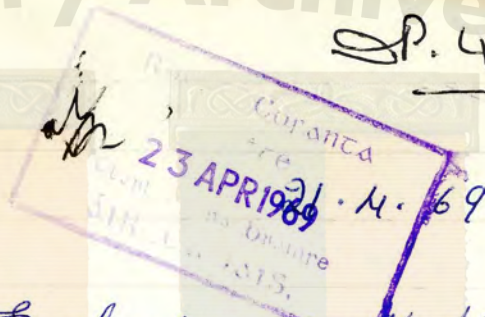
