Dear Sir My Son James Connor who joined the National forces at a time when he was earning £2.12.6 per week and served under the late Captain Lehan and Lieutenant O'Callaghan of the 1<sup>st</sup> Western Division at Kelloe was mortally wounded in the Kelloe battle on the 27<sup>th</sup> of Sept being shot through the forehead and died on the 29<sup>th</sup> at the nursing home Tralee Kindly let me know if the Provisional Government would be willing to pay me and his aged mother any compensation being one of the chief providers of our family if so would you kindly send me an official form for such application if you consider it is applicable when your kind favour will oblige his broken-hearted old father James Connor
