Report as to dependency of Applicant or of the motherless children upon Deceased at the time of his death.

The Civic Guard Report states that the applicant is in very poor circumstances. She has at present five persons, nephews and neices living with her, all of which with the exception of one are unemployed. The employed member is earning but 10/- or 12/- per week in a Paper Factory. As far as can be ascertained by discreet enquiries deceased was mainly responsible for the upkeep of his brothers and sisters, who are yet juvenile, attending school (elementary) and have no prospects of employment.

Mrs. Woods' case appears to be a deserving one.

Further report: -

There are five in family - two girls aged 6 years and 14 years, three boys aged 17, 20 and 24 years respectively. None of above are now earning, except for the two elder boys who get work now and then at the Quay. One of the above was in the National Army for sometime and was drawing £1.8.0. Army Allowance. The parents of deceased are alive; but do not live with their family. The mother is a patient at Castlebar Mental Hospital, the husband earning his living in England. He does not support his family. Claimant is a casual servant earning at times 10/- per week. Her sister who is aged 48 years lives in the house with her. She has three brothers also living in England.
