I beg to bring under your notice the case of Dependents of Volunteer P. McEllin whose was killed in action during the recent fighting round Newport. The deceased, who was a vol. of long standing, attested at Athlone last May and was attached to the Nth. Mayo Brigade. His mother is a widow and received no dependents allowance since he joined up, though application was made a few times, the last was made to Asst. Pay Officer some weeks ago. She is in very poor circumstances and prompt attention to her case, if at all possible, would be desirable.

I do not like troubling you in the matter and only for case is an urgent one I would not take it out of the normal course. She has two other sons, one aged 15, in very indifferent health, the other, though over 30 is in not way able to replace the young fellow who joined up when the call came.

Trusting you may be able to give matter your personal attention.
