8th day of May 1922
and was aged 18½ years.

killed in an ambush
carried out by the
Irregulars upon a
party of our troops
marching to Mass
On Sunday morning
last from Bushfield
(outside Denagh).

sympathy in your
sad loss.

Your son's funeral
will arrive in
Maryboro by Rail
from Poscrea at 3:30
p.m. tomorrow (Tuesday)

3.
19th September '22:

The remains will
be taken from Railway
Station here and brought
to your house at
Ballinamoyler.

During the present
situation and due to
the fact that I need
all troops possible here
I cannot leave any
there in your place
tomorrow night.

I regret this very
much but you will
understand the situation.

The bearer of this will
explain matters to you.

Kindly tell him
your arrangements
re funeral.
