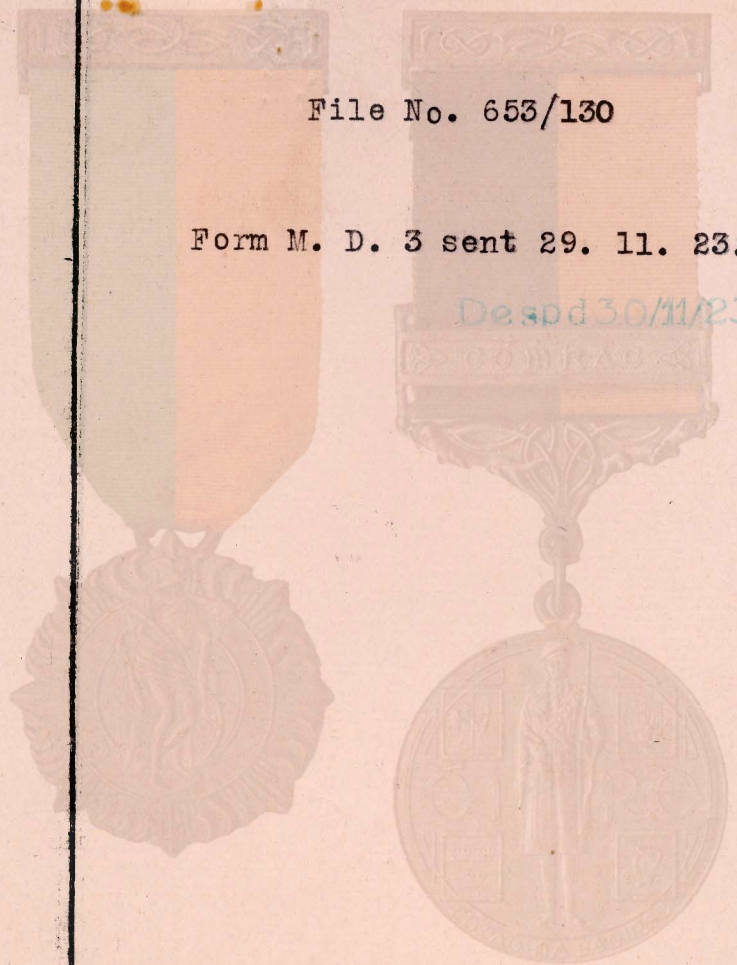

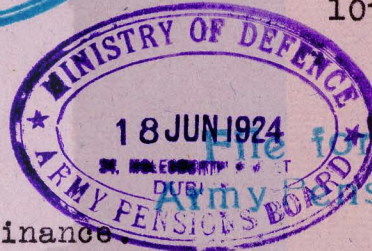

With reference to Mr. Almond's Minute No. 653/130 of the 29th November, 1923, regarding an application for the payment of compensation to Mrs. Catherine Traher, 23, Dunbar Street, Cork, in respect of the death of her husband Patrick Traher, I am directed by the Minister for Defence to inform you that the late Patrick Traher may properly be regarded as having been a supporter of the Irish side in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 4 (a) of the "Heads of Working Arrangements" (C.P.3648).

On the 24th February, 1920, Traher and three others were standing at the corner of Patrick Street and Pim Street, Cork. One of the four men was in possession of a hand grenade which he was handling in a careless manner, resulting in the grenade falling to the footpath when on contact it exploded wounding a number of persons including Traher. The latter was taken to hospital where he succumbed to his wounds next morning. There was no Crown Forces operating in the vicinity at the time of the occurrence.

The Minister is not aware of any objection to the consideration of the case with a view to immediate payment by the appropriate authority.

[" Whilst applicant's husband was standing at the corner of Patrick Street and Princes Street, Cork with three other men, a bomb was fired from Careys Lane (at the off side of Patrick Street) right across the Street which landed at the said corner exploding with violent force. After the explosion it was found that Patrick Trahey was very seriously wounded. He was immediately taken to hospital but owing to the serious nature of his injuries he died the following morning at 7 o'clock. Deceased was Vice-Commndt. 2nd Batt. 1st Cork Brigade, I.R.A. and was on duty with others at the time of the explosion."]
