On the 24th February, 1920, Traher and three others were standing at the corner of Patrick Street and Pim Street, Cork. One of the four men was in possession of a hand grenade which he was handling in a careless manner, resulting in the grenade falling to the footpath when on contact it exploded wounding a number of persons including Traher. The latter was taken to hospital where he succumbed to his wounds next morning. There was no Crown Forces operating in the vicinity at the time of the occurrence. The Minister is not aware of any objection to the consideration of the case with a view to immediate payment by the appropriate authority. ensions Collection
