An unmarried son and daughter live with her. Four other sons and a daughter are at business in different places. The farm is pretty fair, keeping six or eight cows and two horses.

The deceased, Edward McCusker, worked on the farm and applicant would be dependent on him to the extent that a man is employed to do the work formerly done by him at an outlay of probably £30. per annum and keep.
