Dear Mr Ryan

Please submit my claim for compensation for the loss of my brother James who was killed in action in Shrolo in May 1921. He fought in Dublin in 1916 from which he spent some time in the Mater hospital for injuries he sustained. He also fought in all the fights in Limerick, Tipper. & Cork during the War. He was financed the whole time from the home-sted which I could not afford.



As the Germans raided the  
house night and day  
for three years and

home at time. I never  
looked for compensation  
from the last Government  
as I always supported
