A Chara,

With reference to your letter of the 30th ultimo inquiring regarding your entitlement to any medal for participation in the struggle for National Independence, I am directed by the Minister for Defence to state that by virtue of your pre-truce service, you are entitled to a pre-Truce Service Medal without bar, which was forwarded to you on the 6th instant by registered post. It has occurred to the Minister that you may require your medal to wear at a coming Presidential function in which case it is customary to wear the miniature of the medal. A miniature has, therefore, been forwarded to you by registered post. A charge of 3/6d. is made for this and I am to request a remittance from you at your convenience for this sum.

I am to add that medals with bar are issuable to persons who hold certificates of military service under the Military Service Pensions Acts. The latest date by which applications for such certificates could be made is now past, but it is proposed to extend this date in the near future. If, therefore, you wish to apply for such a certificate, an application form on which to do so will be issued to you on the extension of the date for applications. It should, perhaps, be mentioned that continuous active service with the national forces in any one or more of a number of specified periods commencing in April, 1916, and ending on the 11th July, 1921, is essential in order to qualify for a certificate of military service. It is not possible to establish your position in this respect from the records of this Department, but if you wish to pursue the matter by way of an application for such a certificate, the matter will, of course, be further considered.
